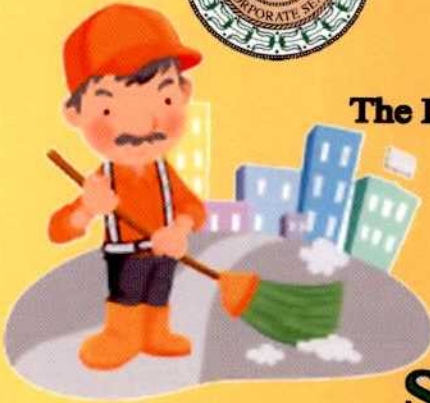

PHASE I: VOLUNTARY COMPLIANCE

Designed to **ENCOURAGE** Residents, Property Owners and Businesses to join in a:

"Maintain Our City With Pride" Campaign

May 4, 2009 to June 5, 2009
DPW will provide free

- ◆ One (1) Broom
 - ◆ One (1) Rake
 - ◆ Five (5) Bags Per Property Owner
 - ◆ Special Pick-Up on Mondays
- No Pre-registration required. Just visit the Clean & Green Center on Elmwood Avenue (973-266-1021) with proof of residency.
 - Yard/basement/attic trash must be able to be lifted and bagged or bundled no more than 4ft long and no more than 40 pounds.
 - Deposit trash at the curb for pick-up, call DPW (973-266-5330) and request a "Spring Clean-Up" collection.

PHASE II: COMPULSORY COMPLIANCE

Designed to **ENFORCE** the Provisions of the East Orange Code with respect to:

"Neighborhood Maintenance" Campaign

June 8, 2009 to October 31, 2009
DPM Inspectors will inspect and search exteriors of every premises

Property Owners and Businesses whose premises are found to be in sub-standard conditions will be subject to:

- Notice of Code Violations with a specific abatement time.
- Court Summons beyond the given abatement time.
- Penalty not less than \$100 not more than \$2,000 or imprisonment for a term not to exceed 90 days, or both.
