The City of East Orange, Department of Recreation & Cultural Affairs is accepting registrations for the upcoming Tee Ball program, scheduled to begin April, 2009. Boys and girls between the ages of 5-8 yrs. are eligible to play. Children must be 5 years of age by March 31, 2009. Please understand the emphasis of the program is instruction, recreation, and sportsmanship.

Parents/guardians must register in person & provide prove of residency and a copy of the child's birth certificate. **In order for this program to be successful, we are asking parents and community members to serve as volunteers (Coaches, Team Parent, Officials, etc...**

In fairness to all, sign up is first come, first served. All games will be played at one site, there will be no transportation for this program, so please arrange car-pools before start up date & arrange to sign up friends together on same team to avoid switching teams later. When signing up your child choose a field close to home for a Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Saturday practice day. Practices will begin the last week in April.

DEADLINE FOR ANY CHANGES IS APRIL 17, 2009. Registration is \$5.00 plus a \$10.00 uniform fee (Tee shirt & cap) per child, payable at time of registration. As of this date, all team rosters are completed & sent to the coaches, who in turn will call all team members to notify them of all Tee Ball details: times, dates, & places of practices. In addition, at this time, shirts & hats are ordered to insure that uniforms are ready for the **FIRST BIG GAME!**
